Economic Development: Braintree is in an excellent position to take advantage of regional market trends including the growth of the life sciences sector, while also supporting a strong small business environment. Though the number of jobs in town decreased slightly over the last decade, some important industries and subsectors have grown, including Administration & Support, Health Care, Construction, and Pharmaceutical manufacturing. Furthermore, there could be real estate development opportunities throughout Braintree that support future business growth, especially for adaptive reuse of existing buildings, redevelopment of sites that are vacant or no longer serve their best use, and for infill in places that are already more thoroughly developed.
